1. Call to Order at 6:05 PM.
2. Roll Call

3. Approval of February Minutes
 - a. Jenny moved to approve; John seconded. All in favor, motion passed.
4. Citizen Comments
 - a. Laurie Chase and Travis Mullenix: Glenwood Springs Arts Council invites the City to collaborate with other arts organizations in the city. Travis would like to propose “cross pollination” opportunities such as a Walk Glenwood type event. Laurie also is favorable to the idea of an Arts District.
 - i. Laurie will send Karstin the Arts Council’s monthly meeting information to be shared to the board again.
 - ii. Suggestion to have staff send a Doodle Poll for joint meeting between the Arts and Culture Board and the Arts Council separate from regular monthly meetings of the groups.
5. Word on the Street – Board Comments
 - a. High School is interested in doing a mural project on the electrical boxes around town. Staff has inventoried eligible electrical boxes and will reach out to Ty.
6. Yampah Mural Proposal – Katy Curry
 - a. Each year, Yampah High school closes for a week for interims when students can complete offsite non-traditional learning. This year’s interims

week will be the first week of May. May 1st would be teacher prep day and May 2nd – 5th students would paint.

- b. Yampah High School students would like to complete a mural inside of the bike path tunnel between their school and the Community Center that is subject to graffiti often.
 - c. Sketch of proposed mural design presented.
 - d. Mural not planned to cover the entire arch, but a framed area instead along one side.
 - e. John Carr will reach out to Katy on best materials and practices for murals.
 - f. Suggestion to have a cooperative marketing effort to let people know it's happening and discourage graffiti.
 - g. Steve will reach out Parks to get the approval to use the site.
 - h. Board supports concept, would like final concept presented at April's meeting.
 - i. Staff will get approvals from Community Development on concept and color palette once final concept is received from Katy.
7. Scope of Work for Professional Conservator for 5-year Inventory Assessment
- a. As outlined in the Art Plan, the City has drafted a scope of work for a professional art conservator to come evaluate our collection, provide condition reporting, and maintenance recommendations.
 - b. Karstin and Annie will be meeting virtually with one on Monday to discuss.
 - c. Stefanie will provide additional conservator contacts she has gathered.
8. Mural Festival Next Steps
- a. September 2023 date seems unattainable.
 - b. Cooperative opportunities should be explored.
 - c. Staff complete some of the leg work on code compliance and building owner contacts. Shooting for three viable walls to ensure canvases are available prior to moving forward.

- a. Scheduling for capital projects at the Art Center has moved to the fall and will affect exhibitions schedules.
 - b. Additional discussion on scheduling at April's meeting when construction dates are more solid.
10. Letter of Support for Glenwood Springs Storm Drain Improvement Project Grant Application
- a. Department of Local Affairs Grant application will support the installation of storm sewer in some of our downtown alleys.
 - b. Engineering would like support from the Arts and Culture board for the alley improvements in the hopes that after improvements, the areas could be further revitalized with art.
 - c. Jenny moves to support the letter of support, John seconds. All in favor.
 - d. Stefanie will write the letter of support and provide to Terri.
