3. Approval of March Minutes
 - a. John moved to approve; Jenny seconded. All in favor, motion passed.
4. Citizen Comments – 3 minutes per citizen for items not on agenda
5. Word on the Street
 - a. Stephanie – Members of this board attended the Arts Council meeting last month.
6. Final Concept for Yampah High School Mural in tunnel – Katy Curry
 - a. Katy was unable to attend but provided staff with the drawing of their proposal to share with the board.
 - b. 6'x8' in the tunnel between Yampah High School and the Community Center on the Midland path.
 - c. John Carr is going to conduct a workshop for the students tomorrow, April 18th.
 - d. Students will complete the project the first week of May.
 - e. No objections by Economic Development, just the guidance that the path remain partially open and that there are no reflective paints or neon colors.
 - f. The city will purchase anti-graffiti coating.
 - g. Motion: Jenny moves to support the Yampah High School mural. John seconds. All in favor.
7. Conservator Update
 - a. Annie and Karstin are going to complete a walkthrough of the City's art-heavy locations to do a preassessment of most pieces to see if any were

definite pieces to be professionally assessed and if any could be postponed. A priority list of pieces to be assessed will be developed.

- b. Staff have spoken to Pacific Coast Conservators about what a professional assessment includes, to get an idea of the scope and costs.
8. Exhibition Update
 - a. Annie is working on a schedule for an exhibition(s) this year at the Community Art Center or possibly other locations since the construction schedule at the Community Art Center has changed.
 9. Mural Festival Revisited
 - a. Proposal to have a “Better Together 2.0” project this fall, sometime between September 8th to 24th, that will include murals on electrical boxes, a public wall(s) if able to be secured, and a community engagement piece downtown.
 - b. Sponsorships will be sought. Corina has brought an application from Alpine Bank once the project is solidified.
 10. Electrical Boxes Project Ideas
 - a. Will be built into “Better Together 2.0” project.
 11. Staff Report
 - a. Upcoming programs include Family Creativity Lab, Clay Classes, and Summer Youth Art Academy.
 - b. Brian Weller has been hired as our part-time Art Coordinator. He has a background in special effects, makeup artistry, illustration, and art instruction.
 - c. Rod emphasized the importance of Master Planning and conducting needs assessments to get the input from the community on what they want to see and what their needs are to build out a plan for how the department services the community over the next 5 years.
