Dear Mr. Hershey:

Your CORA request of August 16, 2023 for “any and all email messages between City Council Members and/or with and between City (Senior) Staff about me (Anthony/Tony Hershey) since August 10, 2023” involves such a large volume of records that the custodian cannot reasonably prepare or gather the records within the three-day period without substantially interfering with the custodian’s obligation to perform his or her other public service responsibilities.” C.R.S. Sec. 24-72-203(3)(b)(III). As such the City is entitled to 7 additional working days to complete the production of the requested records.
